### **Application checklist for fall 2008 admission**

This list is provided to help applicants organize the required materials for complete application. It is not a step-by-step checklist. Unless explicitly stated, the items do not need to be completed in the order listed. These steps apply to all applicants, regardless of campus choice.

All application materials must be received in the Twin Cities Office of Student Services (see contact information below) before your application will be reviewed.

### **PharmCAS Application**

- \_\_\_\_\_ Complete the PharmCAS application. The application and instructions are available at [www.pharmcas.org](http://www.pharmcas.org). The final deadline for submitting the PharmCAS application is February 1, 2008. However, applicants are strongly encouraged to submit an application earlier.
- \_\_\_\_\_ Pay the PharmCAS application fee.
- \_\_\_\_\_ Send official transcripts from each college attended to PharmCAS.
- \_\_\_\_\_ Arrange for three people to complete and send recommendations forms to PharmCAS. Instructions on submitting recommendations are located on the PharmCAS Web site. The University of Minnesota College of Pharmacy requires 3 letters of recommendation.
- \_\_\_\_\_ Frequently check your PharmCAS application status through PharmCAS to track status of transcripts, recommendations, and PCAT scores to ensure they were received by PharmCAS. Contact PharmCAS regarding any materials not received.

### **Pharmacy College Admissions Test (PCAT)**

- \_\_\_\_\_ Register for the PCAT and pay the registration fee. Registration information and test dates are available at [www.PCATweb.info](http://www.PCATweb.info). Applicants must take the PCAT by October 20, 2007 for consideration for fall 2008 admission.
- \_\_\_\_\_ Send PCAT scores to PharmCAS (code 104). Applicants must submit a PCAT score with a scored writing subtest. PCAT exams offered since June 2005 have included this subtest.

## University of Minnesota College of Pharmacy Supplemental Application

- \_\_\_\_\_ Review the supplemental application questions at [www.pharmacy.umn.edu/pharmd/admissions](http://www.pharmacy.umn.edu/pharmd/admissions). Begin preparing essay responses.
  
- \_\_\_\_\_ Once your PharmCAS application has been verified and sent to the College of Pharmacy, you will receive an e-mail indicating you may complete the supplemental application online. Go to: [www.pharmacy.umn.edu/pharmd/admissions](http://www.pharmacy.umn.edu/pharmd/admissions) to complete the supplemental application. You will need your PharmCAS ID number to access the application. The supplemental application must be submitted by February 15, 2008.
