To provide College of Pharmacy students with important career opportunity information, comply with federal laws regarding donations and recruiting and control the type and number of recruiting events, the College of Pharmacy has adopted this recruiting and student-access policy. All companies interested in connecting with our students may attend our annual Career Fair. This event is normally held in November on both the Twin Cities and Duluth campuses. It consists of a lunch-time Career Fair to which all 600 students in the college are invited. We schedule interview sessions specifically for those anticipating graduation in the spring.
