Accreditation Status

The Accreditation Council for Pharmacy Education (ACPE) certifies that the University of Minnesota College of Pharmacy has fulfilled the accreditation requirements set forth by ACPE for the professional degree program in pharmacy and is hereby granted accreditation status through June 30, 2016.

The ACPE Board of Directors reviewed the Doctor of Pharmacy program of the University of Minnesota College of Pharmacy for purposes of continued accreditation at its January 20-24, 2010, meeting. This review was based upon due consideration of the Evaluation Team Report from the on-site evaluation dated September 28-October 2, 2009, the College's self-study, and other communications received from the institution.

On Time Graduation Rate for Class Year 2016

- 165 students were admitted in 2012 as the class of 2016
- 149 students graduated on time
 - 10 students were delayed, 6 students left the program
- The on time graduation rate is 149/165 (90%)

Success of Graduates

- Three months after graduation in 2016, out of 132 graduates who completed a college survey, 53% found employment, 41% began a residency, and 5% will go on to a fellowship or graduate education.
